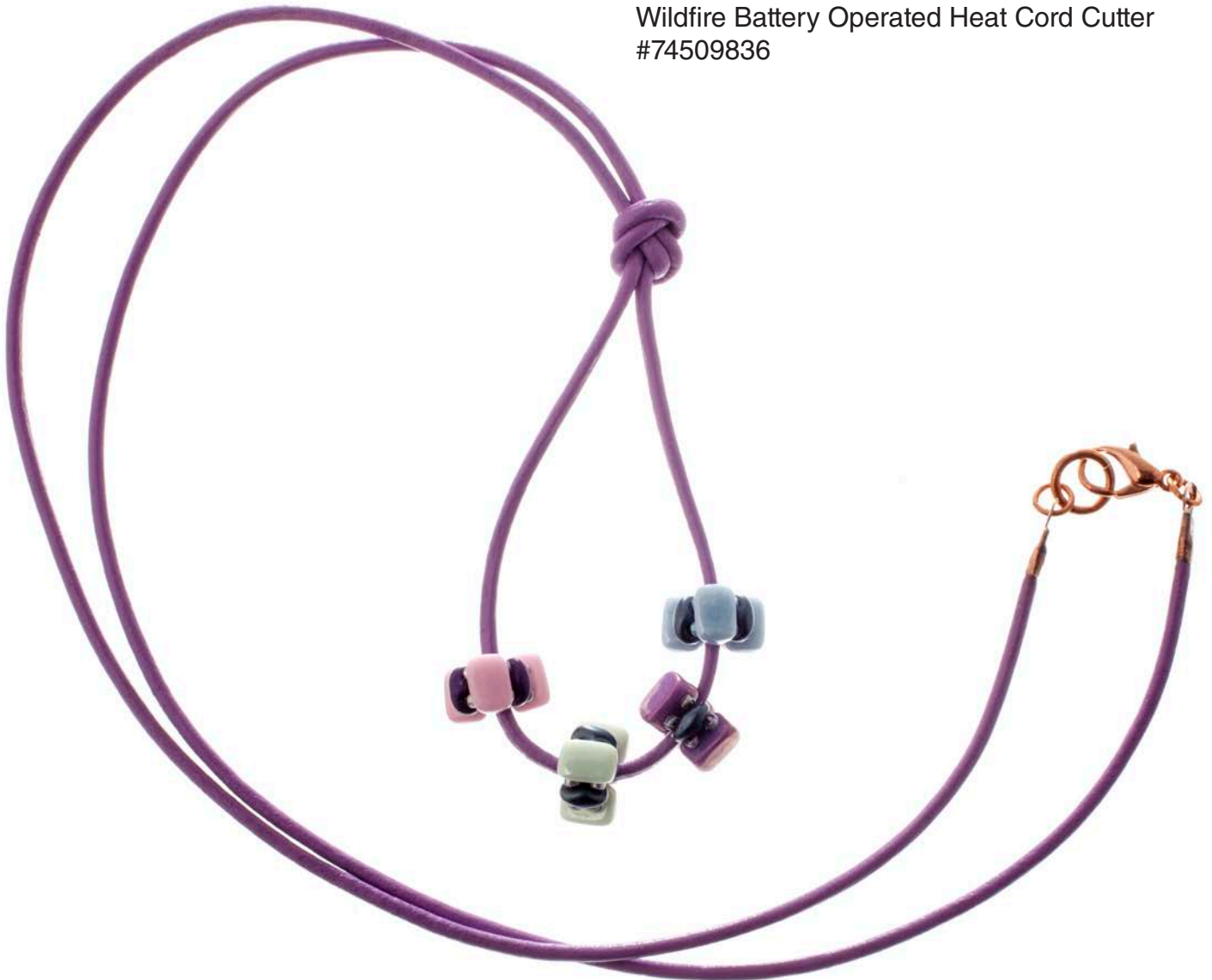

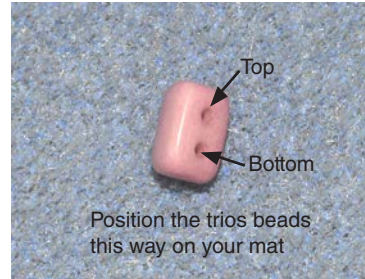


# Designed for John Bead Corp.

## Materials: To make one 'ring'

T (3) Trios Beads  
SD (3) Superduo Beads  
S11 (12) Miyuki Seed Beads 11/0 Beading Thread  
Beading Needle - Size 11 Tulip Beading Needle  
Thread Zapper or Scissors  
Beading Mat

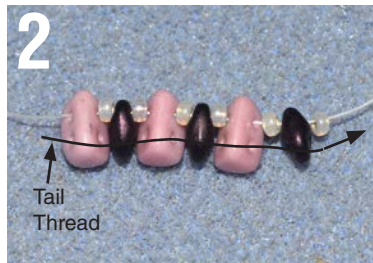


## Tip:

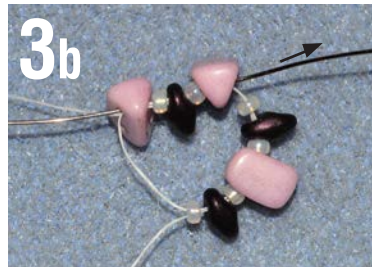
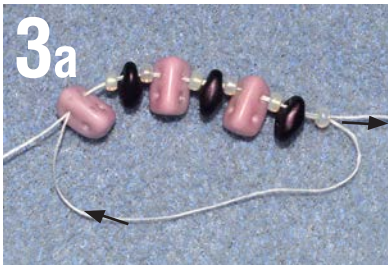
Check to make sure the holes are open in the 2 hole beads (Trios and Superduos).

**1** Thread a size 11 beading needle with 26 inches of prepared beading thread. Leave a 6 inch tail thread.

Start



Pick up (1 T + 1 S11 + 1 SD + 1 S11) 3 times so there are 12 beads in total.(photo 2).



Sew through all the beads again (photo 3a.), plus 1 T + 1 S11 + 1 SD + 1 S11 + 1 T. Thread exits a T bead (photo 3b). Pull the beads together gently to form a circle.(photo 3c).



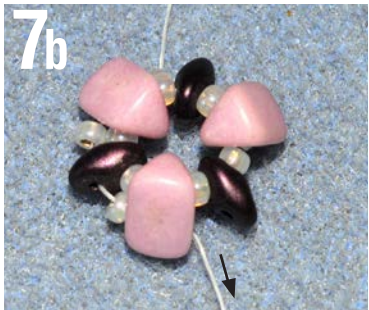
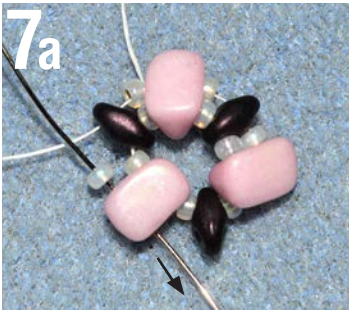
Sew through the bottom hole of the T just exited. (photo 4)



5  
Pick up 1 S11. Sew through the bottom hole of the SD; the first SD after the T bead exited in Step 4.



6  
Pick up 1 S11. Sew through the **bottom** hole of the next T in the round.



Continue adding S11 beads between each of the T and SD beads until this row is the same as the top (first) row. (photo 7a, 7b, 7c and 7d).



8  
Sew through all the beads in the bottom row again. Gently pull the beads together to complete "The Ring".



9  
Weave the working and tail thread into the bead work. If you like, make a few half hitch knots to secure the thread. Trim any excess thread. (photo 9)
