Step by Step Instructions for *Triple Oval Earrings*

Pattern by *Debra Schwartz* for John Bead Corp.

Techniques: Basic bead weaving knowledge, experience working with pliers

Size: Approximately 2 1/2 inches long

You will be able to make Triple Oval Earrings in many colorways with the great assortment of colors available for the Czech Candy Oval Beads and the Czech Terra Intensive Seed Beads from John Bead Corp.

Materials: to make one earring

| (12) S10 R – Czech seed beads size 11 Terra Intensive Red | 2 jump rings 4mm or 5mm |
| (16) S10 O – Czech seed beads size 10 Terra Intensive Orange | 2 Earring hooks |
| (10) S10 B – Czech seed beads size 10 Terra Intensive Brown | Beading Thread – – Black Nymo or color of your choice. |
| (2) S6 – Czech seed beads size 8 Terra Intensive Brown | Beading needles – Gold Eye size 11 & 12 or Tulip Needles size 11 & 12 |
| (2) Os – Czech Candy Oval bead 4x6mm | Bead mat, Scissors or thread burner |
| (2) Om – Czech Candy Oval bead 6x8mm | Chain Nose pliers |
| (2) OL – Czech Candy Oval bead 10x12mm | |

Tips:

- Thread tension: Be careful not to pull the beading thread to tight. Snug the beads up to each other but not tight.
- Switch to a smaller beading needle when necessary, to avoid breaking beads.
- You can use slip knots when weaving the working and tail threads into the bead work.

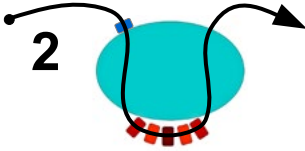


Triple Oval Earrings

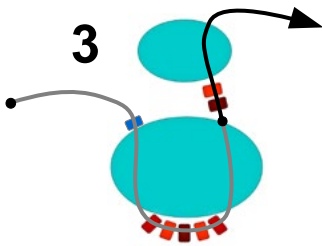

1. Begin by threading a size 11 beading needle with 3 feet of prepared beading thread. Attach a stop bead and leave a 4 to 6 inch tail thread.

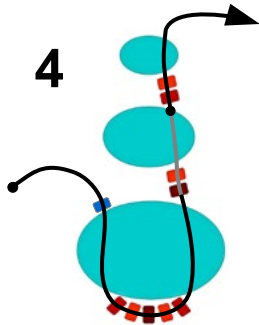
2. Sew down through the Left hole in the OL. Pick up 1 S10R + 1 S10O + 1 S10B + 1 S10O + 1 S10R. Sew up through the Right hole in the same OL. [illus. 2]



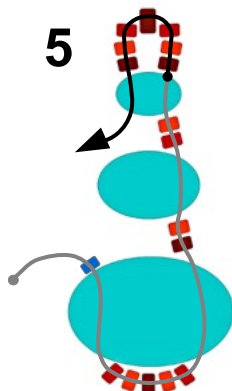
3. Pick up 1 S10B + 1 S10O. Sew up through the Right hole in an Om. [illus. 3]



4. Pick up 1 S10R + 1 S10O. Sew up through the Right hole in an Os. [illus. 4]



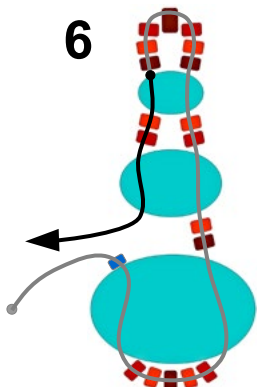
5. Pick up 1S10B + 1 S10O + 1 S10R + 1 S6B + 1 S10R + 1 S10O + 1 S10B. Sew down through the Left hole of the Os. [illus. 5]



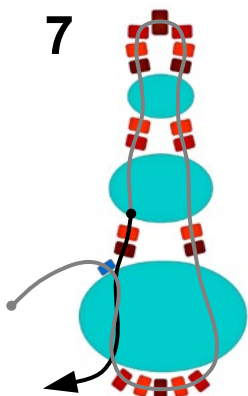
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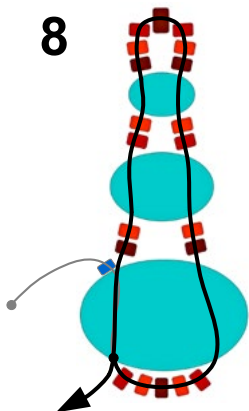
6. Pick up 1 S10O + 1 S10R. Sew down through the Left hole of the Om. [illus. 6]



7. Pick up 1 S10O + 1 S10B. Sew down through the Left hole of the OL. [illus. 7]



8. Sew through all the beads again; 5 S10 + OL + 2 S10 + Om + 2 S10 + Os + 3 S10 + 1 S8 + 3 S10 + 1 Os + 2 S10 + 1 Om + 2 S10 + 1 OL. [illus. 8]

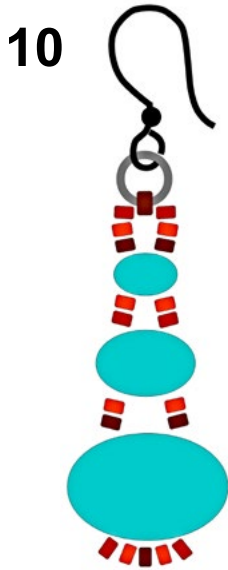


9. Remove the stop bead. Weave the working and tail threads into the bead work. You can use slip knots here and there to secure the thread.

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10. Open a 4mm or 5mm jump ring. Place an earring hook and the S8 at the top of the earring on the jump ring. Close the jump ring. [illus. 9]



11. Repeat Steps 1 to 10 to make a second earring.

That's it. You're done!!!
