# Step by Step Instructions for *Halloween Triangle Earrings*

Pattern by *Debra Schwartz* for John Bead Corp.

**Techniques:** Basic bead weaving knowledge, Peyote Stitch, Herringbone Stitch

**Size:** Approximately 1 inch x 1 inch

## Materials used for the earrings:

Miyuki Nylon beading thread - white

Beading needles – Gold Eye size 11 & 12  
or Tulip Needles size 11 & 12

Bead mat, Scissors or thread burner

(2) 4mm jump rings

(2) Earring hooks

Bent nose pliers or Chain nose pliers

## Optional: Bead hanger

(4) silver plated daisy spacers

(4) 3mm silver plated metal beads

(2) 25mm silver plated eye pins

(2) 2/o Czech Cornelian White Star  
Black beads

## Tips:

- Thread tension: be careful not to pull the beading thread to tight
- Switch to a smaller beading needle when necessary, to avoid breaking beads.

# Halloween Triangle - Pumpkin

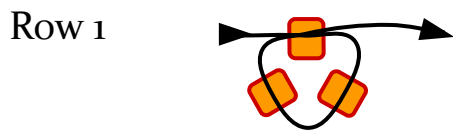
**Delica Beads:** Approx. 1 to 2 grams of each color per triangle

- A** (214) D11A DB1133 opaque mandarin orange
- B** (38) D11B DB0010 black opaque
- C** (27) D11C DB2141 duracoat opaque spanish olive

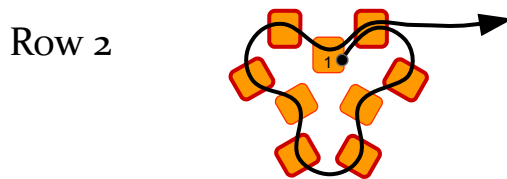

1. **Start** by threading your beading needle with 3 to 5 feet of prepared beading thread. Remember to leave a 6-8 inch tail thread; you will weave this into the bead work later.

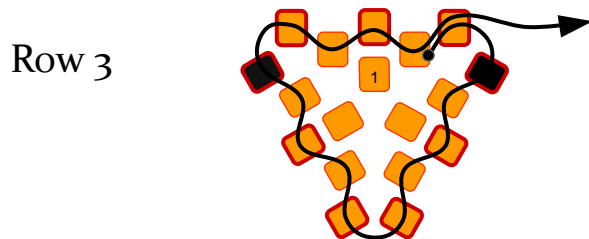
2. Pick up 3A. Sew through the 1<sup>st</sup> A bead strung to make a circle.



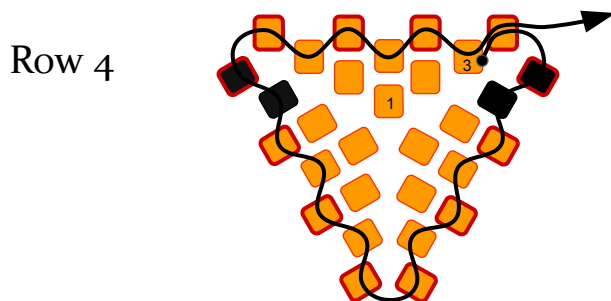
3. Pick up 2A. I will refer to these as corner beads. Sew through the next A in the set of 3 beads. Add 2A corner beads 2 more times. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.



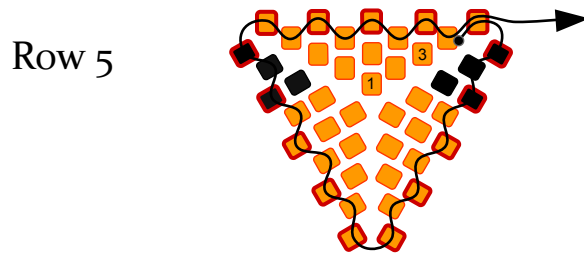
4. Add 1A + 1B corner beads. Peyote 1A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 1A. Add 1B + 1A corner beads. Peyote 1A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A bead added at the beginning of this round.



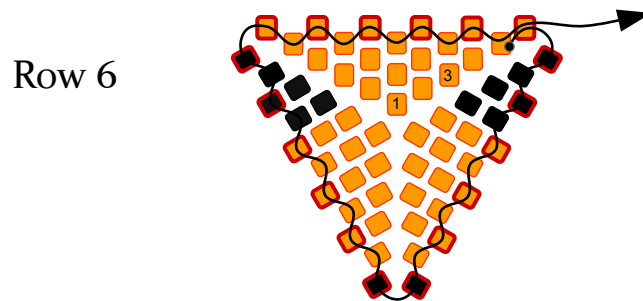
5. Add 1A + 1B corner beads. Peyote 2A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A. Add 1B + 1A corner beads. Peyote 2A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> BA added in this round.



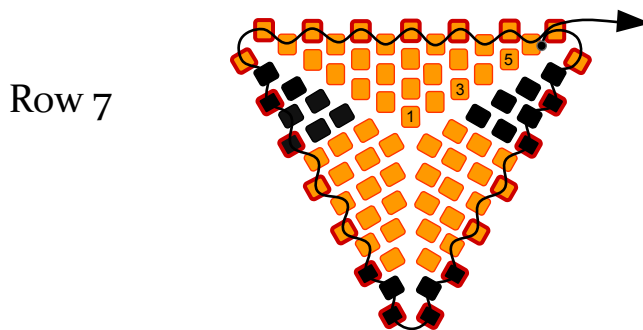
6. Add 1A + 1B corner beads. Peyote 1B + 2A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 1B. Add 1B + 1A corner beads. Peyote 3A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.



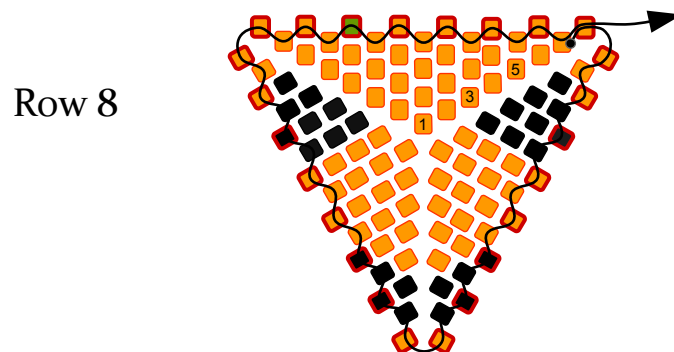
7. Add 1A + 1B corner beads. Peyote 1B + 3A. Add 2B corner beads. Peyote 3A + 1B. Add 1B + 1A corner beads. Peyote 4A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.



8. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2B + 2A + 1B. Add 2B corner beads. Peyote 1B + 2A + 2B. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 5A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.



9. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 1A + 1B + 2A + 2B. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2B + 2A + 1B + 1A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 1A + 1C + 4A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.



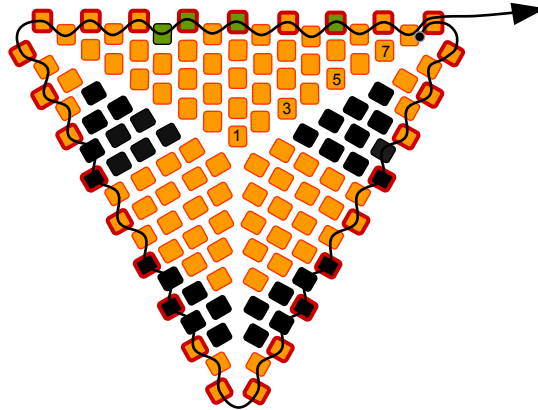
# Halloween Pumpkin Triangle

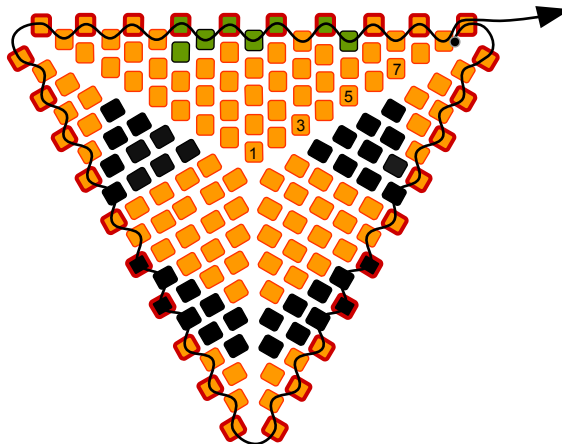
**10.** Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 1B + 1A + 2B + 1A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 1A + 2B + 1A + 1B + 2A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 2C + 1A + 1C + 1A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.

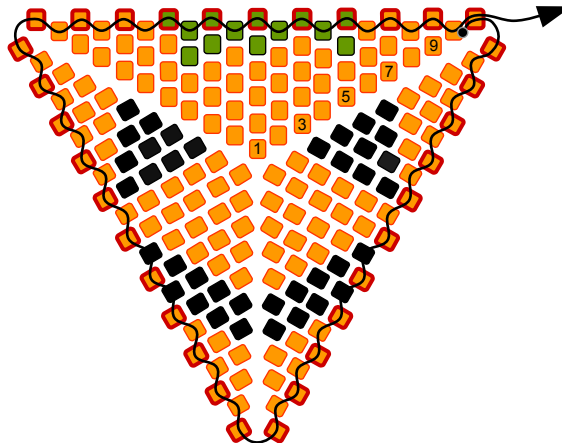
**11.** Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 4A + 2B + 2A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 2B + 4A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 4C + 2A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.

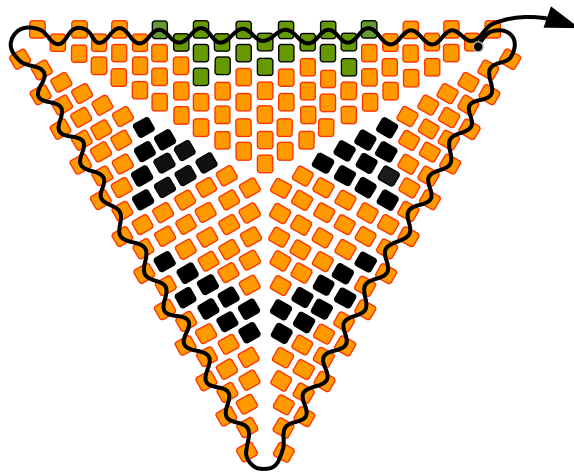
**12.** Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 9A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 9A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 5C + 2A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.

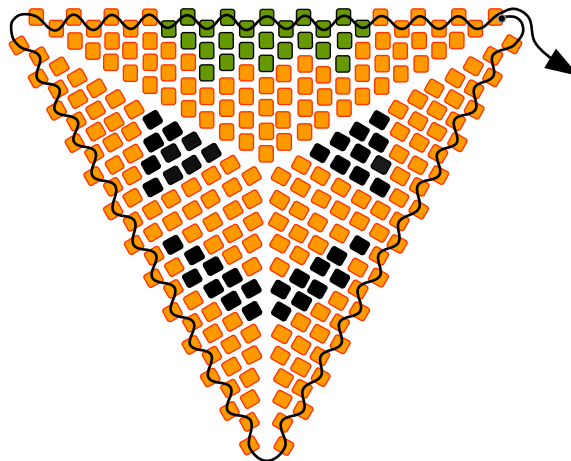
**13.** Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 10A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 10A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 2A + 6C + 2A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.

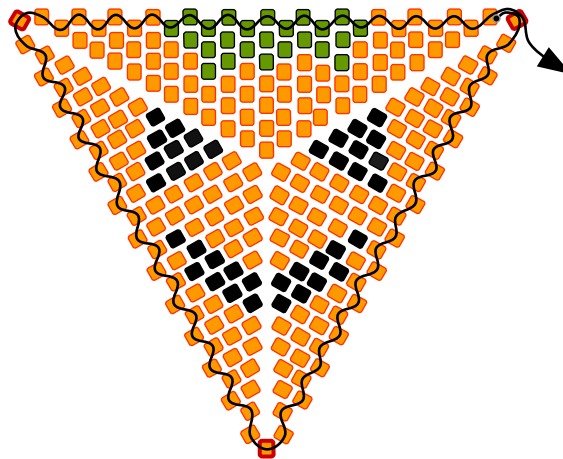
**14.** Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 11A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 11A. Add 2A corner beads. Peyote 3A + 5C + 3A. Step up. Thread exits the 1<sup>st</sup> A added at the beginning of this round.

Row 13



**15.** Point round: Add 1A. Sew through the bead work to the 2<sup>nd</sup> corner. Add 1A. Sew through the bead work to the 3<sup>rd</sup> corner. Add 1A. Thread exits 3<sup>rd</sup> corner bead.

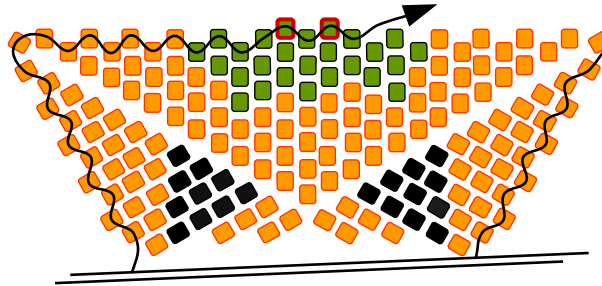


# Halloween Triangle - Pumpkin

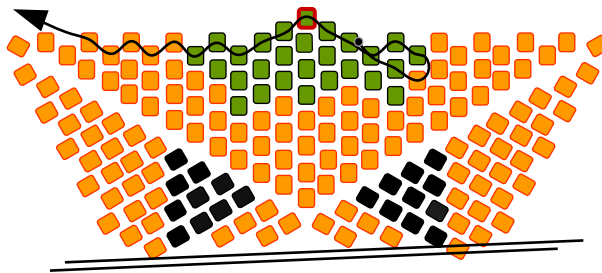

**16.** Sew through the bead work to the 5th up bead, on the outside row, at the top of the triangle. Peyote 2C beads. Thread exits the 7<sup>th</sup> up bead on the outside row.



**17.** Sew through the bead work following the illustration so the thread exits the 2<sup>nd</sup> C bead added in step 16. Peyote 1C. Sew through the bead work.

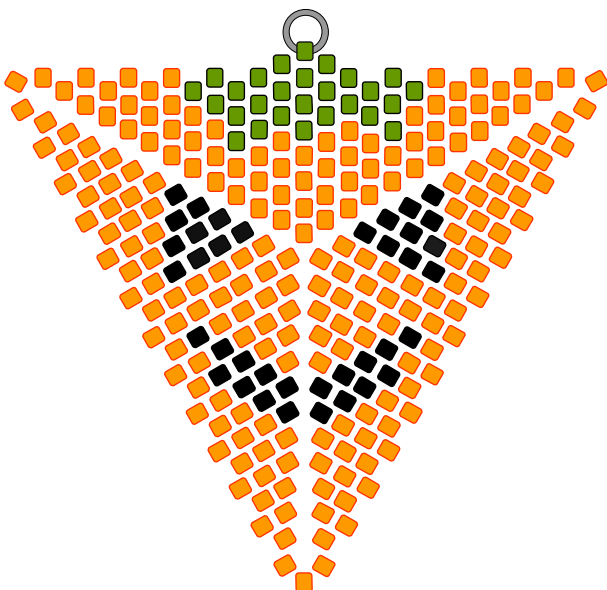


**18.** Weave the working and tail threads into the bead work. Trim any excess thread.

**19.** Attach a 4mm jump ring to the C bead at the top of the tab.

**20.** Attach an earring hook to the jump ring.

Make 2 for a pair of earrings!



**Beading Etiquette:** Although this is a free pattern please, be kind and give credit to the designer when you share a photo of the bead work online or when you sell them.

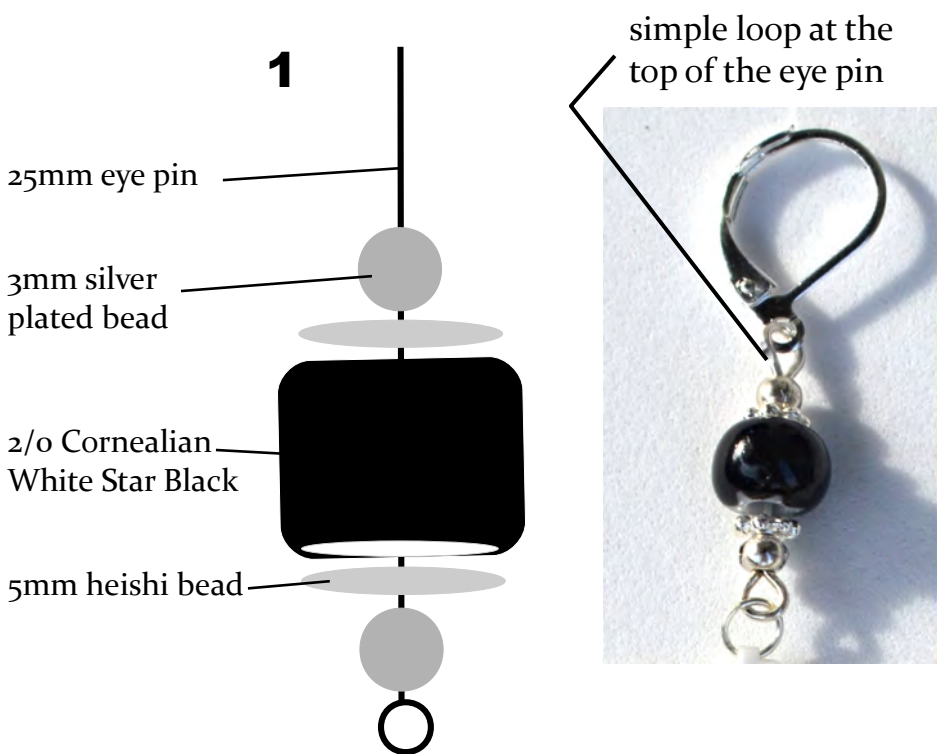


# Halloween Triangle Earrings

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## Optional: Bead hanger

1. Slide onto a 25mm eye pin – (1) 3mm silver plated bead, (1) 5mm antique silver spacer heishi bead, (1) 2/o Cornealian White Star Black, (1) 5mm antique silver spacer heishi bead, (1) 3mm silver plated bead.
2. Make a simple loop at the top of the eye pin.
3. Open the 4mm jump ring. Slide one loop of the bead hanger onto the jump ring that already has the triangle on it. Close the jump ring.
4. Open the loop on the earring hook. Slide the loop at the other end of the bead hanger onto the earring hook loop. Close the earring hook loop.



Finished earring with bead hanger.



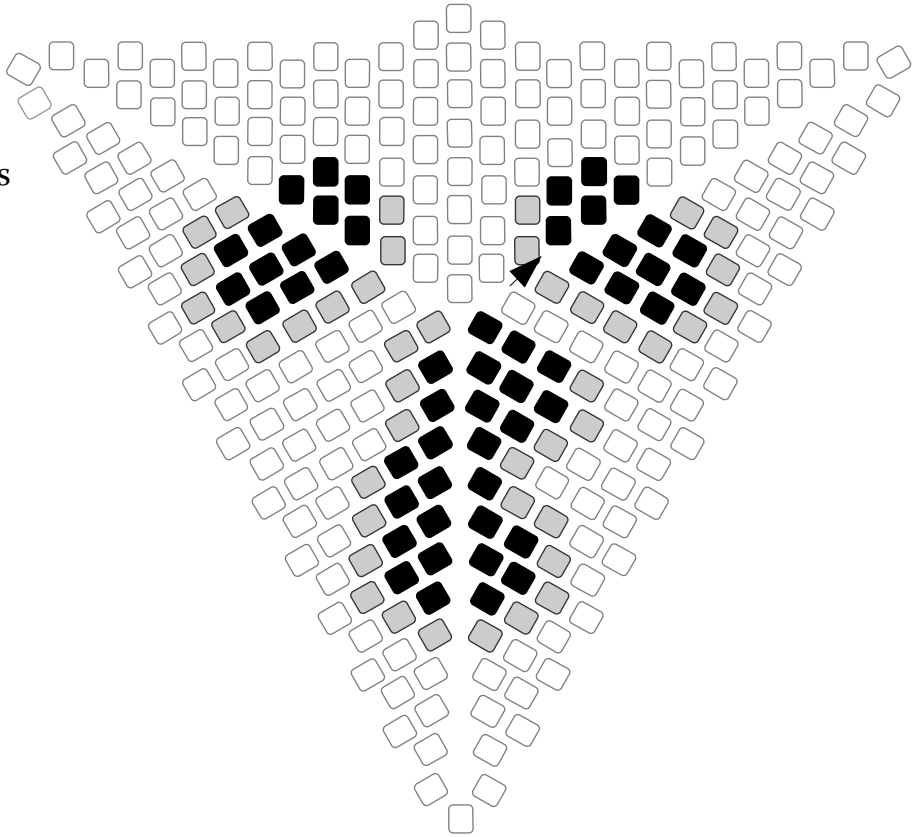

- A** DBo200 Chalk White Opaque
- B** DBo010 Black Opaque
- C** DB2391 Fancy Lined White



## Word Chart – Ghost

Make 2 for a pair of earrings.

Remember to **step up** at the end of each round.

Letters/numbers in parenthesis are corner beads.

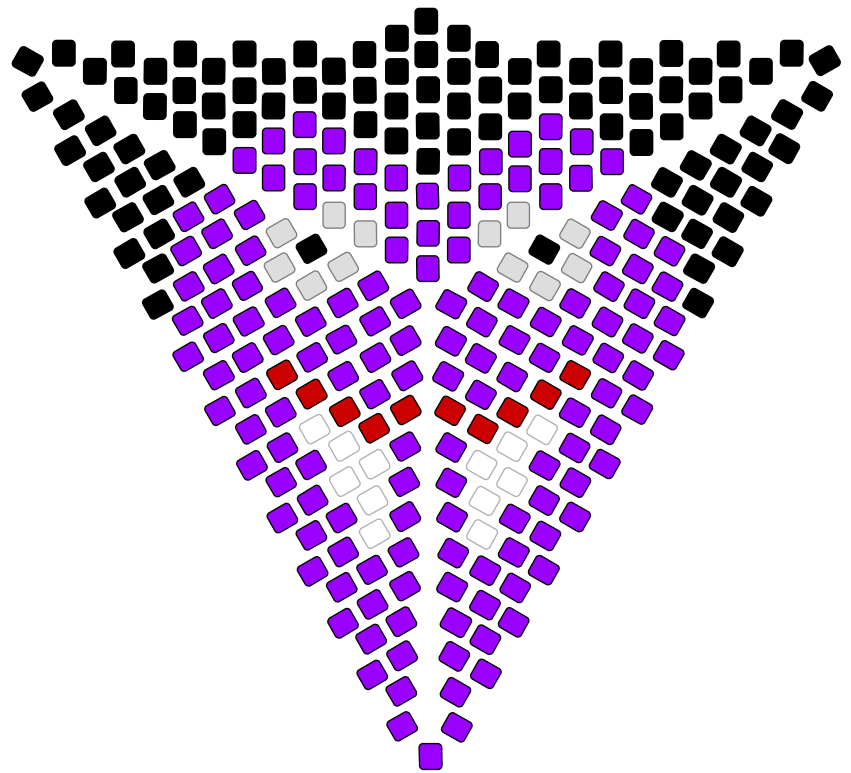

- A** DB2140 Duracoat Dark Mauve
- B** DBo010 Black Opaque
- C** DB2391 Fancy Lined White
- D** DBo602 Red Silver-Lined
- E** DBo200 Chalk White Opaque



## Word Chart – Dracula

Make 2 for a pair of earrings.

Remember to **step up** at the end of each round.

Letters/numbers in parenthesis are corner beads.

2. (2A),(2A),(2A)
3. (2C),1A,(2A),1A,(2C),1A
4. (1C,1B),2A,(2D),2A,(1B,1C),2A
5. (1A,1C),1C,2A,(2A),2A,1C,(1C,1A),3A

7. (2A),3A,1D,1E,(2A),1E,1D,3A,(2A),2A,1B,2A

15. Using B beads, repeat Steps 15 to 19 on pages 5 and 6 to add the point at the top of the triangle.

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
