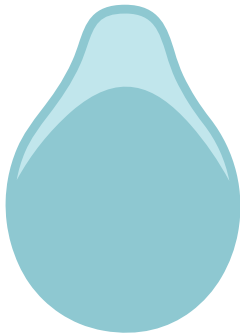

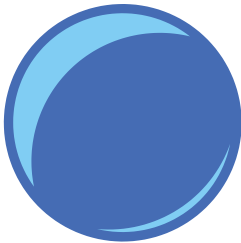

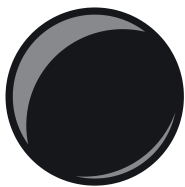
This project can be created with either a 12mm or 8mm Candy Rose bead. Both configurations are explained in this tutorial.

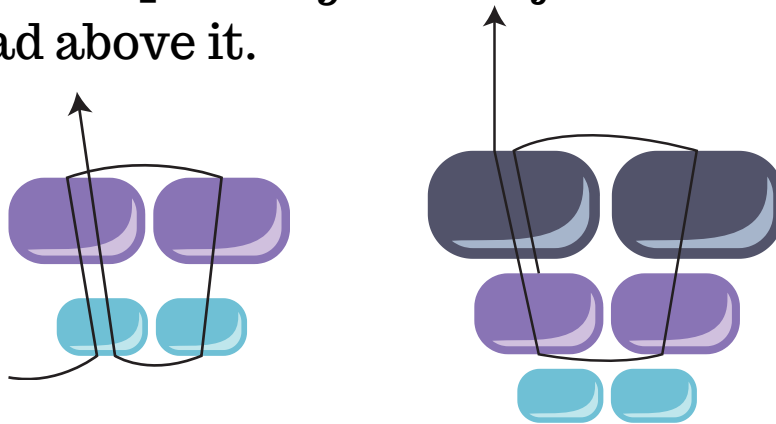

## Design 1 - 12mm Candy Rose Petal Bracelet

### Step 1

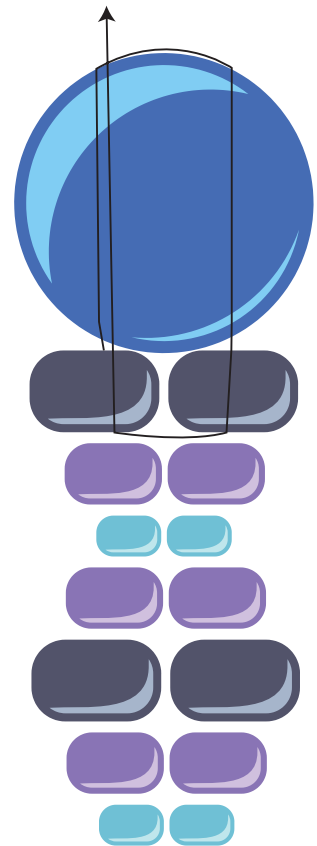
Cut 40" [102 cm] of thread. Leaving a 12" [30 cm] tail, pick up one 11/0, two 8/0, and one 11/0 beads. Go back through the first 11/0 and 8/0 added. Pick up two 6/0 beads and go through the 8/0 bead below. Turn and come up through the adjacent 8/0 bead and 6/0 bead above it.



Continue building single-column herringbone stitch rows, as described above, in the following pattern:  
8/0, 11/0, 8/0, 6/0.

### Step 2

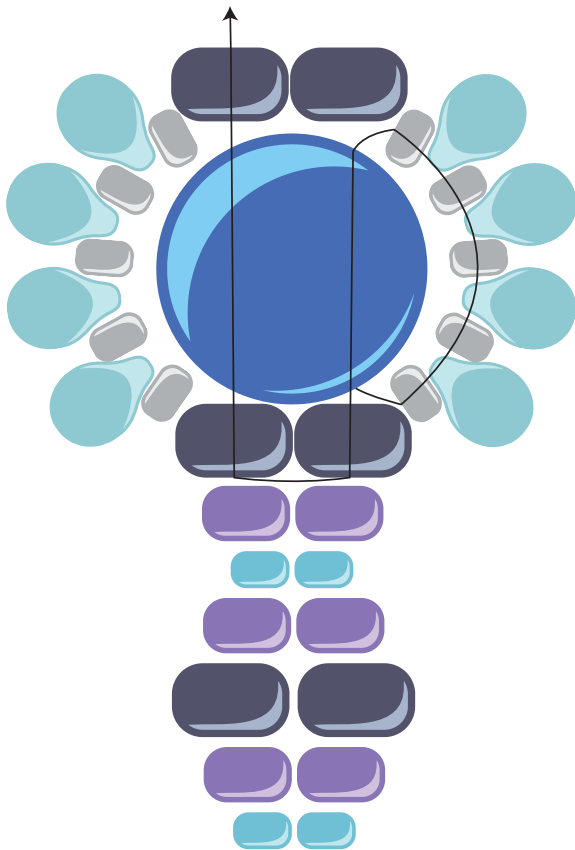
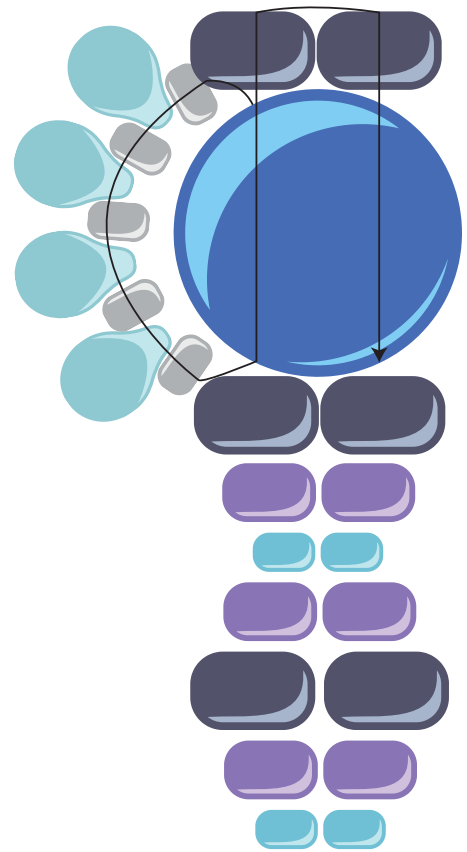
Go through the left side hole of a Candy Rose bead. Turn and come back down through the right side hole. Continue through the 6/0 bead below. Turn and go up through the adjacent 6/0 bead. Go through the left side hole of the Candy Rose bead.



### Step 3

Pick up an 11/0 bead and a Pip bead four times, plus one 11/0 bead. Go up from the bottom, through the left-side hole of the Candy Rose bead.

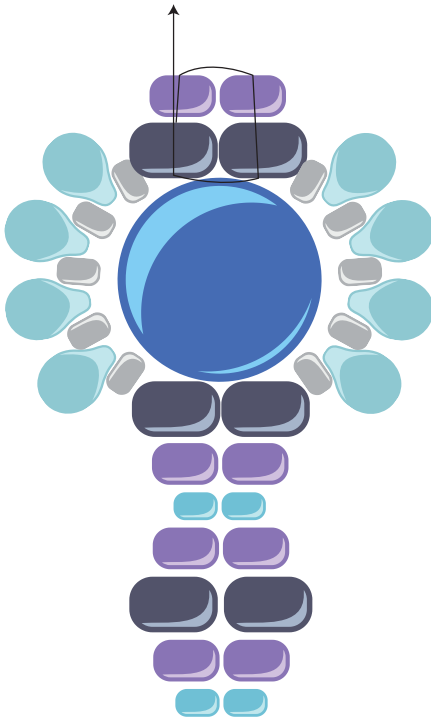
Pick up two 6/0 beads. Go down through the right side hole of the Candy Rose bead.



### Step 4

Pick up an 11/0 bead and a pip bead four times, plus one 11/0 bead. Turn and go down through the right side hole of the Candy Rose bead, from the top to the bottom.

Continue through the 6/0 bead, turn and come back up through the adjacent 6/0 bead. Continue up through the left side of the Candy Rose bead and the 6/0 above.



### Step 5

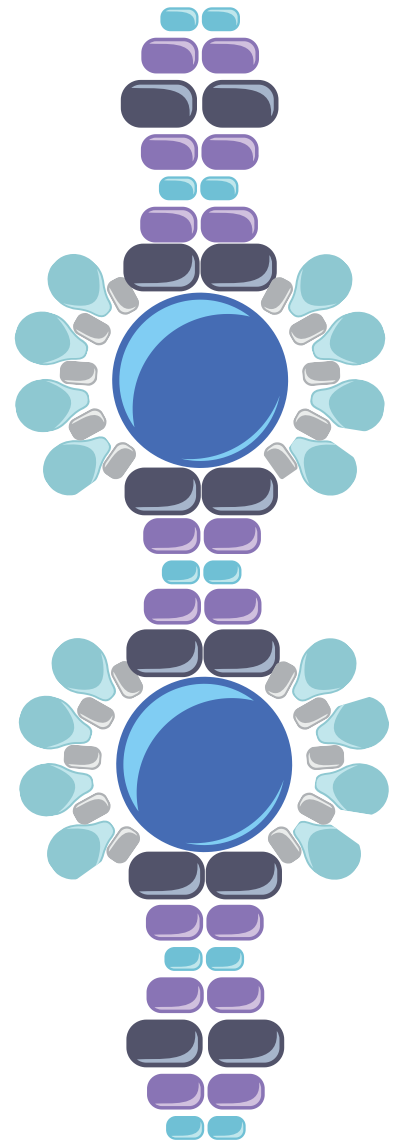
Pick up two 8/0 beads. Go down through the 6/0 bead on the right. Turn and come up through the adjacent 6/0 bead and the 8/0 above.

### Step 6

Continue to build rows in the following pattern: 11/0, 8/0, 6/0.

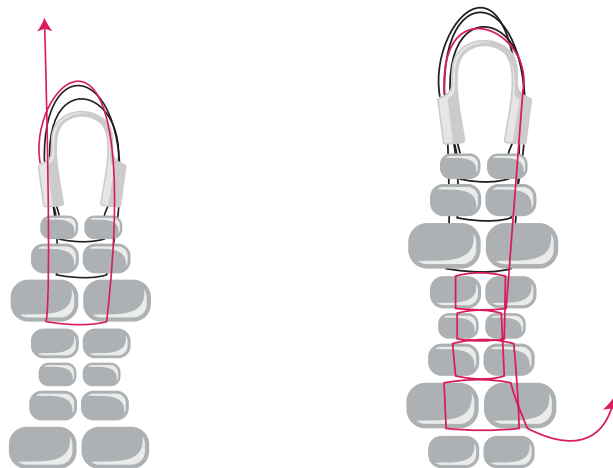
Repeat Steps 2-5 to a total of five Candy Rose beads.

End your bracelet with the following pattern above the last Candy Rose bead: 6/0, 8/0, 11/0, 8/0, 6/0, 8/0, 11/0.



## Step 7

Finish each end of the bracelet with a wire guardian. Go through the wire guardian three or four times, looping through the beads below as shown. Weave in thread by looping through the beads as shown. Trim excess thread.



Wire guardians are optional - you can also create a loop using four, size 11/0 seed beads and weave them onto each end using the same method as shown above.

Add the clasp of your choice using jump rings to each end of the bracelet.

## Design 2 - 8mm Candy Rose Bead

To create this bracelet with an 8mm Candy Rose bead, follow the same steps 1 through 7 described for the 12mm bead, with the following variations:

Add the Candy Rose Beads after the 8/o beads in the pattern as opposed to after the 6/o.

Add only three repeats of pip (instead of 4) in steps 3 and 4.
