John Bead Czech Glass Seed Beads Size 11/0

Transparent Aqua Amethyst, SKU 10627230

Wildfire Beading Thread .006, SKU 10470337

Size #12 Hard Beading Needle, SKU 10348545

Leverback Earring Hoops, SKU 10239252

Precision Scissors, SKU 10591717

Beading Mat, SKU 10348546

Any color combination of John Bead Czech Seed Beads in Size 11/0 will work for this project.

1 Hour Class. Earrings may take 1 to 2 hours to complete.

Create these fun, hoop earrings in a snap with John Bead Czech Seed Beads! In class we will use a three column, netted rope stitch to create a tube that will slide over the lever back hoops.


Abbreviations used in this text:

S11A - Transparent Aqua Amethyst

S11B - Opaque Turquoise Blue


Step 1

Cut 60 to 70 inches of beading thread and thread a size #12 beading needle. That measurement assumes you are using the largest of the hoop sizes from the lever back hoop card. Adjust this if you are making a different hoop size.




Round 1

String [(1) S11A, (2) S11B] three times. Go back through the first S11A. Reinforce this path through all the beads again. Exit from the first S11A.




Round 2

[Pick up (1) S11B, (1) S11A, (1) S11B. Go through the next S11A in the round] three times. Go through the first S11B and S11A added in this round.



Repeat round 2 approximately 29 more times, for a total of 31 rounds. Your netted rope should measure approximately 3 inches in length.



Step 2

After the last round, close off the tube by [picking up just (2) S11B and going through the next S11A], three times.

Step 3

Weave in the working and tail threads. To do this, follow the netted path through several rows and trim.

Slide the tube over the ear post side of the lever back hoop. If you used tight tension, this tube may be a slightly tight fit. This is actually helpful, in that the tube will not slide on the hoop while you wear it.

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
