Beginner Wire Wrapping and Beadweaving

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Perfect the Right Angle Weave Technique with Danielle Wickes! Learn to create this fun, embellished design with John Bead Czech Seed Beads. It's beginner friendly, fast, and gift-ready!

Abbreviations used

S6A - Size 6/0 Czech Seed Bead - Blue Iris

S6B - Size 6/0 Czech Seed Bead - Aqua Purple Lined

S8 - Size 8/0 Czech Seed Bead - Chalk Purple

S11 - Size 11/0 Czech Seed Bead - Aqua Purple Lined

Step 1

Using 2" headpins and S6A, create 12 to 14 wire wrapped dangles. Set Aside.

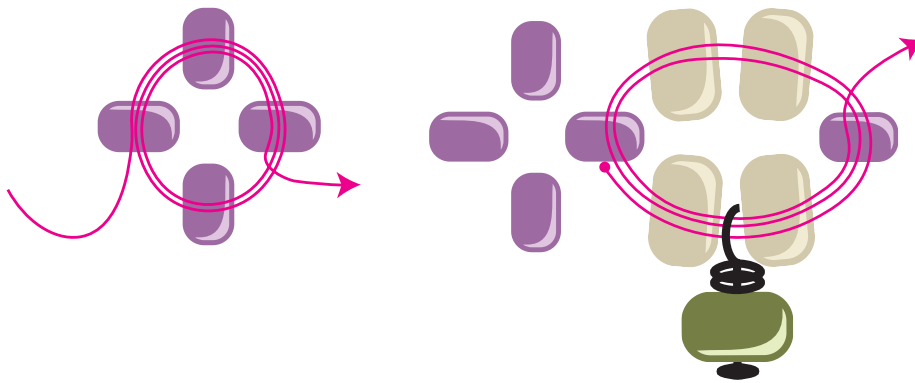


Step 2

Cut 60" of beading thread. Leaving a 10" tail, string (4)S8. Go back through all four beads and continue through the first S8 strung. A square, star shape will form with the S8 beads. Go through the next (2)S8.

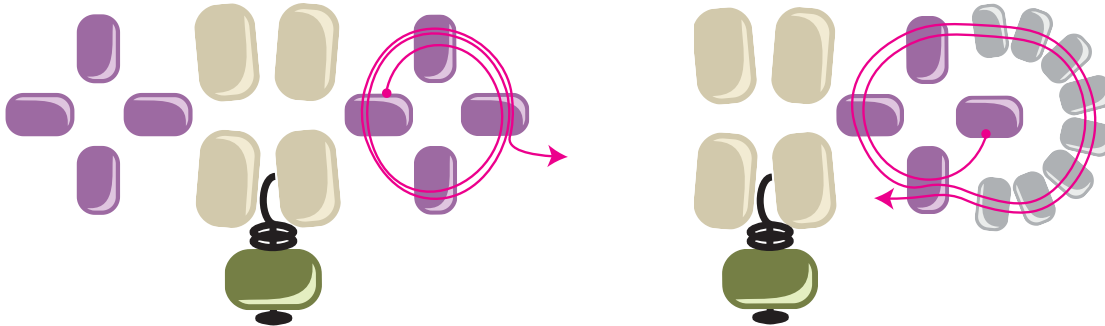
Step 2

String (1)S6B, (1)wrapped dangle, (1)S6B, (1)S8, and (2)S6B. Go through the S8 your thread is exiting from, entering in the opposite side as your exiting thread. Go through all the beads again to reinforce, then continue once more through the first (2)S6B and the next S8.



Step 3

String (3)S8. Go back through the S8 your thread is exiting, entering in the opposite side as your exiting thread. Reinforce this by going through all the beads again. Continue through the next (2)S8.



Step 4

Repeat Steps 2 and 3 to create the desired length.

Step 5

Loop through the next (3)S8. String (8)S11. Skip (1)S8 and go through the next S8. {Go through the next (2)S8, (8)S11 and (3)S8} twice. From here, go through the next (3)S8, then weave into the segment of S6 and turn around the next couple segments to secure. Thread a needle onto the tail thread and repeat this step on the starting side.

Step 6

Open a jump ring from the findings pack and attach a clasp to one side. Create a chain of jump rings and secure to the other side. If desired, decorate the last jump ring with seed beads to add weight on the end of the chain for clasping.
