## Intermediate Beadweaving

1 Hour Class



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Gifting handmade this season just got easier with new, Czech seed bead 3-packs! In this class we will adapt a starting square of flat chenille stitch to support a cascading mix of coffee & cream seed beads with gorgeous crystal bicones.

### Abbreviations

S8A - Size 8/0 Czech Seed Bead, Opaque Black

S8B - Size 8/0 Czech Seed Bead, Opaque White

S10A - Size 10/0 Czech Seed Bead, Opaque Black

S10B - Size 10/0 Czech Seed Bead, Opaque White


S10C - Size 10/0 Czech Seed Bead, Metallic Copper

### Flat Chenille Start - Step 1

Cut 50 inches of Wildfire Beading Thread. Leaving a 15" tail, string: (2)S8A, (1)S10C, (2)S8B, (1)S10C, and (2)S8A.

### Step 2

String (2)S8A. Go through the S10C. String (2)S8B. Go through the next S10C. String (2)S8A, heading in the opposite direction, go through the (2)S8A strung in Step 1. Turn direction again and come through the second-to-last S8A added in this step.



### Step 3


String (1)S10A and go through the next S8A. Pick up a new S8A and go through the S10A. Next, continue to weave through the next S8A and the next S8B. String (1)S10B and go through the next S8B and next S8A. String (1)S10A. Go through the last S8A.

### Step 4


String (1)S8A. Go through the S10A. String (1)S8A and (1)S8B. Go through the next S10B. String (1)S8B and (1)S8A. Go through the next S10A and continue through the next S8A. Make a turn and come back through the (2)S8A.

### Step 5


Add (1)S10C, then go through the next (2)S8B. Add (1)S10C and go through the next (2)S8A. Turn and finish a next row with (2)S8A going through the next S10C, (2)S8B going through the next S10C, and finish with (2)S8A, turning and going back through the (2)S8A in the former row.

## Step 9

Cut a 60 inch strand of Nymo thread. Weave into the work until the tail is secure (stops moving when pulled). Weave to exit from an S8A on the bottom of the piece (opposite side of the wire guardian). String (5)S10A, (5)S10B, (5)S10C, (5)S10B, and (5)S10A. String (1)4mm bicone crystal, (1)6mm bicone crystal, and (1)S10A. Skipping the S10A, come back through all the beads. Note on the illustration below the thread path of the turn to create the next strand of fringe. Tip: for some turns it can be direct into the next S8A, but for the others, tilted downward, it's best to turn up through the next two as shown. Finish a total of six fringe strands in the same pattern.
