


## **Boho Geometry**








ESTABLISHED 1954

For this step, flip the pattern upside down. Cut 55-inches of beading thread. Leaving a 25-inch tail, work single-column peyote stitch the widest row and the row above. Weave the working and tail threads to reinforce the sides.




Work decreasing rows of brick stitch. Start each row with two beads under the second thread bridge. Work one bead under each thread bridge for the remainder of the row. Work the last bead out of the top row sitting sideways. Reinforce the last bead, weave in, and trim.



Flip the pattern and work using the tail thread. Weave in to indent, exiting from the third bead. Begin brick stitch with two beads worked into the fourth thread bridge. Complete the row adding one bead at a time through the end of the row, ending with the third-to-last thread bridge.

Continue building decreasing brick stitch rows to the top of the pattern. At the top, work the last bead out of the top row sitting sideways. Reinforce the last bead, weave in, and trim.



Use the included jump rings. Open and feed through the top and bottom seed beads in the design. Attach to an ear wire at the top, and drop charm at the bottom.

Tip: feed the jump rings carefully. It should slide through easily unless it is snagging thread, or due to cutting burs in the metal. Try switching the side of the jump ring being fed through.
