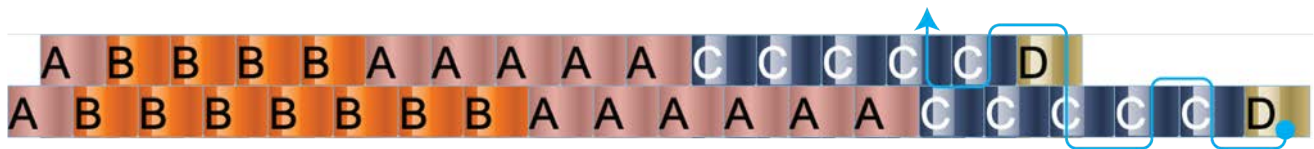
Cut 60-inches of beading thread. Leaving a 25-inch tail, work from the middle of the pattern, completing the wide row and row above using single-column peyote stitch technique.



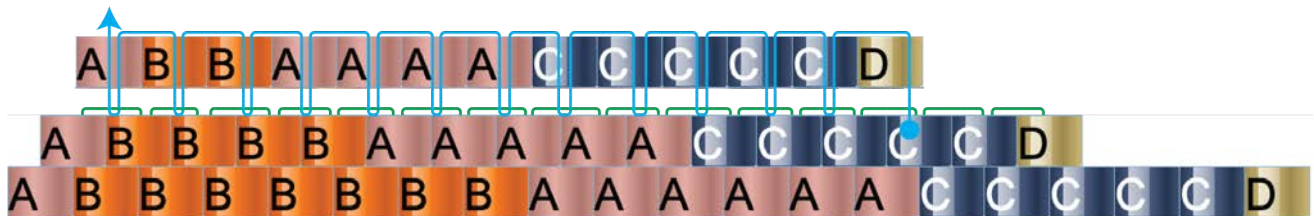
Weave out to ladder stitch the extra three beads in row 1.



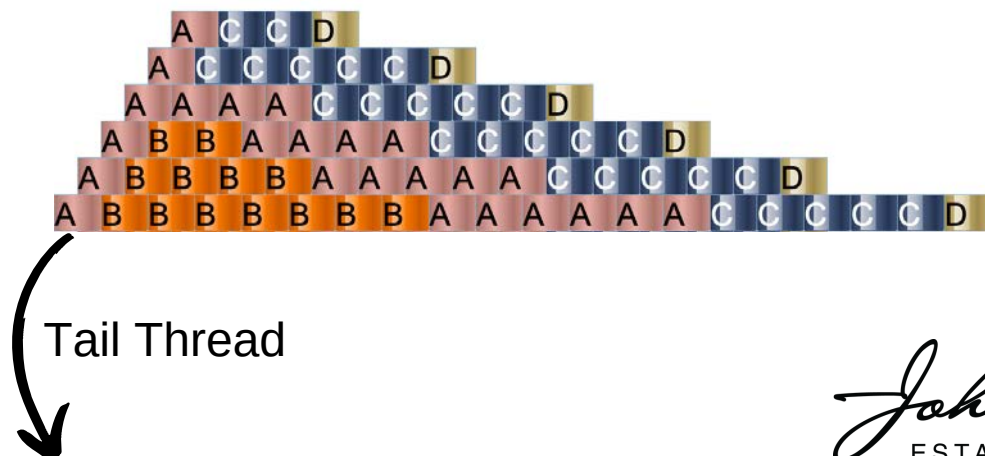
Weave back through the laddered additions to exit from the third bead in from the edge of the top row.



Begin regular, decreasing brick stitch. Start each row with two beads under the second thread bridge. Add each subsequent bead under the next thread bridge to the end of the row.



Create the rest of the rows above using decrease brick stitch as shown above. Weave in working thread and trim. Use the tail thread to build the rows below the starting row using the same method.



Insert a jump ring into the top bead of the pattern. Attach the ear wire to the jump ring and close.

Tip: feed the jump rings carefully. They should slide through the bead easily unless it is snagging thread, or due to cutting burs in the metal. Try switching the side of the jump ring being fed through the bead.



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
