

DIY Crochet Plant Hanger Tutorial – Pattern to follow along with video tutorial.

Create 5 granny squares:

R1 pink:

4ch, sl to close circle

In circle: (3dc, 2ch) x 4

R2 white

(3dc, 2cs, 3dc, 1cs) x4

R3 green:

[(3dc, 1ch), (3dc, 2ch, 3dc, 1ch)] x4

R4 white:

[(3dc, 1ch) x2, (3dc, 2ch, 3dc, 1ch)] x4

R5 pink:

[(3dc, 1ch) x3, (3dc, 2ch, 3dc, 1ch)] x4

R6 white:

[(3dc, 1ch) x4, (3dc, 2ch, 3dc, 1ch)] x4

R7 green:

[(3dc, 1ch) x5, (3dc, 2ch, 3dc, 1ch)] x4

At this time, weave in all ends

Assemble bag: stitch (using green yarn) one side of four of the squares to create the box. Then stitch (all 4 sides) the fifth square to the bottom to create the box.

Create 4 lengths of braided yarn approximately 70cm each by taking three pieces of yarn (1 each color), creating a slip knot at one end, and then chain stitching (all 3 colors at once) until desired length is achieved. Use slip knot at end to finish, leaving excess yarn until assembled.

Assemble by pulling each of the four braided lengths through a corner in the bottom of the basket. Adjust length as desired, tie knot to secure bottom. Then use green yarn and attach each of the four braided yarn lengths to one of the four corners (based on which corner it is in) to secure. Finally, wrap all 4 braids through the wooden loop and then tie yarn around (color of your choice) to secure the top. Cut off excess yarn (top and bottom) as desired.
