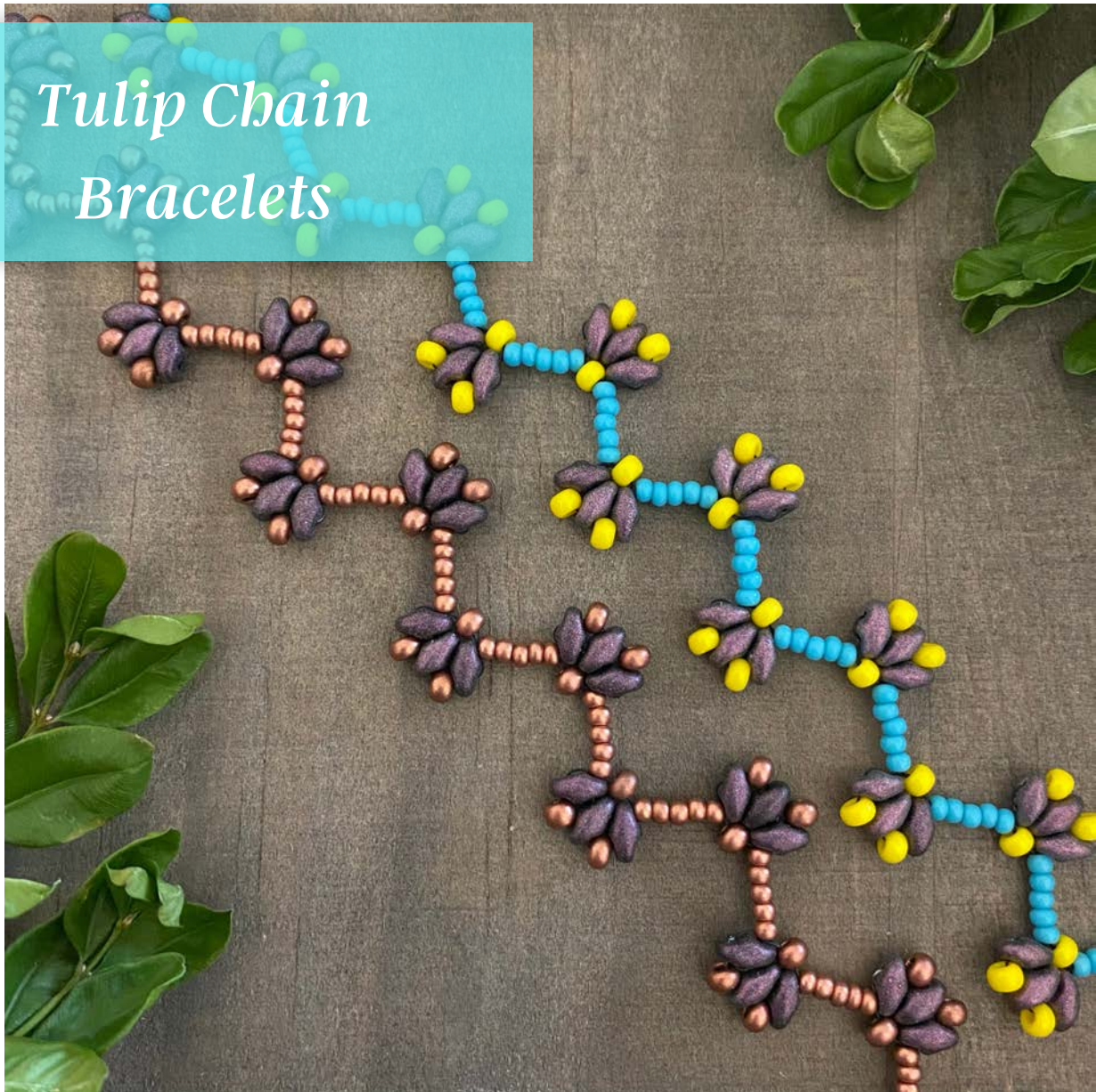

## Tulip Chain Bracelets

# Materials

John Bead Czech Glass Seed Beads in Size 10/0  
Opaque Turquoise SKU 10416631  
Copper Mix SKU 10478820

John Bead Czech Glass Seed Beads in Size 8/0  
Opaque Lemon Yellow SKU 10549097  
Honey Apricot Mix SKU 10549083

John Bead Czech Glass, Two-Hole SuperDuo  
Metallic Suede Purple SKU 10627243

Wildfire Beading Thread .006 SKU 10390892

Finding Variety Pack SKU 10186866

Wire Guardians SKU 10427055

Size #12 Hard Beading Needle SKU 10348545

Time to Complete - 1 Hour

In this class we will create a dainty, Spring-ready Tulip Chain design using John Bead Czech Glass SuperDuo and seed beads!

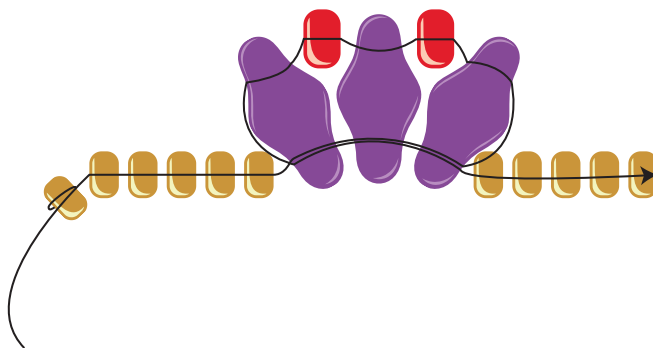
S10A, Size 10/0 Seed Bead  
Duo, SuperDuo Bead  
S8B, Size 8/0 Seed Bead  
Wire Guardian

### Step 1

Cut 70" [178 cm] of beading thread. Thread a size #12 beading needle. This design is worked on a single strand. Leaving a 12" tail [30 cm], using color S10A, string a stop bead.

### Step 2

String (5) S10A and (3) Duo Beads. Turn and go back through the top hole of the last Duo bead added. [Pick up (1) S8B and go through the top hole of the next Duo bead] twice. Turn and go through the bottom hole of the next (3) Duo.

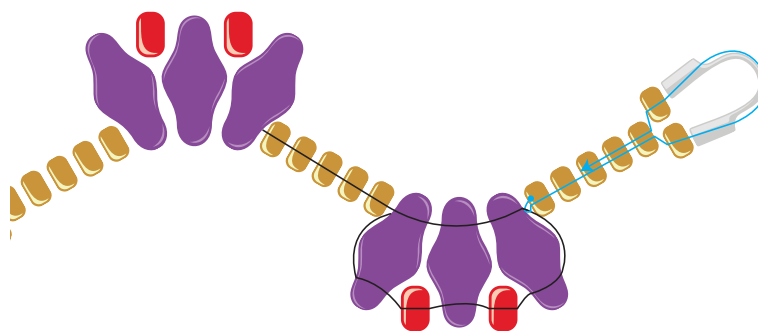
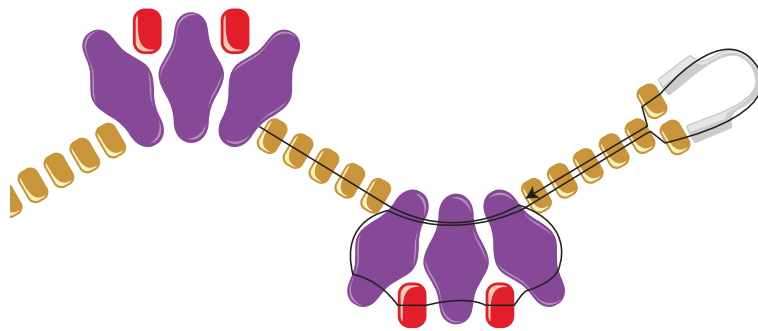


### Step 3

Repeat Step 2 for a total of (15) tulips, which will give you a 6.5" bracelet before clasp. Each additional tulip will add about .75" [1.9 cm].

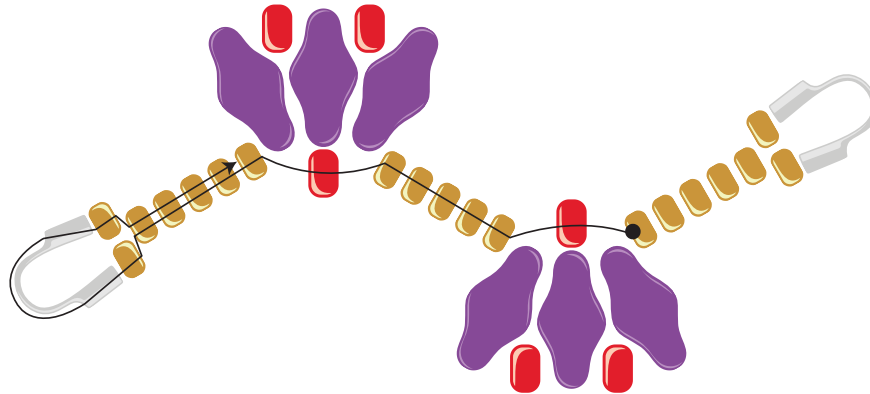
### Step 4

Pick up (1) S10A, go around a wire guardian and pick up (1) S10A. Go through the next (5) S10A. Needle under the thread bridge above the Duo. Use it to turn and head back through the next (6) S10A. Go around the wire guardian again to reinforce. Continue through the next S10A and back through the next (5) S10A.



### Step 5

[Pick up (1) s8B. Skip the Duo beads and go through the next (5) S10A.]  
15 times (or to the end of your bracelet).



### Step 6

Repeat Step 4 to attach and reinforce the wire guardian for the other end of the bracelet.

### Step 7

To weave in working and tail thread, go back through the S10A and use the Duo beads to turn and weave in. Optionally, you can tie a half-hitch knot around the thread in between a set of Duo. Trim remaining thread.

Use your finding pack to add jump rings and a clasp.

You could also make Earrings!
