
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Create these lovely and colorful shoulder dusters with Czech glass tiles and drops!

Abbreviations: S8 - Size 8/0 Seed Bead D11 - Size 11/0 Delica Tile - 6mm 2-Hole Czech Tiles Bead Drop - 6mm Czech Multicolor Drop Beads


Step 1


Cut 120 inches of beading thread and thread on a hard beading needle. Leaving a little more than half that length as a tail, string (9)S8 and go back through the first (3)S8 strung. Pull to tighten. The first part of a single-column peyote row will form. String (3)S8 and go back through the (3)S8 below, the "up" beads. Repeat adding (3)S8 for a total of eight stacks of (3)S8 on the bottom row and 7 on the top row.



Step 2


Use Brick Stitch Technique to work four, decreasing rows with stacks of (3)S8. Work these until you have a top row of 3 stacks. Create a loop of (6)S8 and reinforce. Weave in remaining thread and trim.





Use the tail thread left at Step 1. Weave to exit from the bottom edge and begin to ladder stitch the tiles.

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
Step 3 Continued

Step 4

Build 8 strands of fringe from each hole along the bottom of the tiles. Strand Counts are: (1)S8, (1)D11, ten times (4)D11 (1)Drop (4)D11

Tip: It can be helpful to make the turns for each of the fringe strands in the row above the tiles, meaning, go through the (3)S8 above after going through the tiles to add each strand, make the turn down into the next S8 strand, then through the next hole in the tile.
