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#### Introduction

Join us to create flowing, golden-green fringe earrings! In class we will share how-to plus tips-and-tricks for anchoring starting rows of brick-stitch and finishing with strands of patterned fringe.

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### Abbreviations in this pattern:

S11A - 11/0 Toho Galvanized Gold

S11B - 11/0 Toho Transparent Green

S11C - 11/0 Toho Bronzed Gold

S11D - 11/0 Toho Silver-Lined Light Green

S6 - 6/0 Toho Silver-Lined Light Green

## Step 1

Cut 70 inches of Good Thread Beading Thread. Leaving a 7-inch tail, tie in a double knot to the bottom corner of the frame, non-loop, bottom side.

String (2)S11A. Slide the beads to meet the edge of the frame. Bring your needle behind and around the front of the frame, then back up through the second bead. Pull tight so the beads sit side by side along the bottom of the frame. If desired, bring the tail thread up through the first bead.

Repeat adding (1)S11A for a total of 10 S11A.


# Step 2


Pick up (2)S11A. Needle under the first thread bridge. Come back through the second, S11A and tighten the beads.


Pick up (1)S11 and needle under the next thread bridge. Come up through the bead. Repeat this eight more times.

Add another (1)S11A to the last thread bridge.

Total this row: (11)S11A.









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# Step 3

String a strand of fringe exiting from the last bead added in Step 2. Skip the last bead added. Come back through all the beads and continue through the bead in the second row of brick-stitch. Holding the skipped bead at the bottom of the fringe strand, pull to tighten. Make a turn down through the adjacent S11A in the second, brick-stitch row. String fringe strand 2. Repeat for all 11 strands, stringing the pattern (next page for pattern table).
