Introduction

Sunny Days Ahead! Beautiful Czech Permalux Seed Beads come in the most dreamy groovy colors ever! This warm, earthy design glows in this bold stitch. Join us to learn a beginner-friendly, brick-stitch variation we named the Sunny Scallop Stitch.

S8A - Brown Matte, S8B - Orange Matte, S8C - Dark Yellow Matte

Step 1

Cut a long strand of working thread. Plan to add thread at least once. Leave a 15-inch tail. Ladder a row of 2-stacks of 8/0. Start with (4)S8A.



Step 2


Still working in stacks, pick up (4)S8A and needle under the first thread bridge. Go back through the last (2)S8A. Pick up (2)S8B needle under the next thread bridge. Come up through those (2)S8B.

Carry on like this to complete the row. Notice the extra repeat of S8C in the middle. When you reach the last thread bridge, you'll need to add the last stack of (2)S8A under the last thread bridge.



Step 3

The next row is a decrease row. Again start with (4)S8A. Needle under the second thread bridge. Come up through the last (2)S8A. Complete the row, ending with (2)S8A in the last thread bridge.





Step 4

Repeat Steps 2 and 3 to desired length. End with a Step 3, decreased row. Select a pair of multi-strand connectors. Using the tail thread on the starting side, and the working thread on the finishing side, Exit from one stack, go through the connector, then go through the next stack in the row. Turn to exit from the next stack. Repeat this to the end of the row, then reinforce back through this same thread path. After that, weave in, using thread bridge turns and trim remaining thread.

Step 5

Create a fun chain using 5mm and 6mm rings. As you link the rings, add seed beads to the 6mm rings. Using a 1-inch headpin, create a charm using a lamp work flower bead. On the top side, attach a lobster claw with a 5mm jump ring.
