

# Shadow Blush Earrings

For John Bead

**Materials:**

- 10 pcs Preciosa Czech crystal bead round 4mm crystal velvet (451005-005)
- 10 pcs Preciosa Czech crystal bead round 6mm crystal velvet (451007-005)
- 10 pcs Preciosa Czech crystal round 4mm light rose (451005-060)
- 10 pcs Preciosa Czech crystal round 6mm light rose (451007-055)
- 10 pcs Preciosa Maxima nacre pearl 4mm light grey (131020-031)
- 38 Pcs Preciosa Maxima nacre pearl 4mm rosaline (131020-008)
- 08" Art Wire 20g silver tone wire
- 10 John Bead silver tone eye pins
- 02 pcs John Bead silver tone 8mm jump ring
- 02 pcs John Bead silver tone ear wire

**Tools:**

- Beadalon classic nipper tool (JTNIP1)
- Beadalon slim line round nose pliers (201A-014)
- Beadalon 2 slim line chain nose pliers (201A-011)

**Time:** Less than 1 hour

**Instructions:**

1. **Connector 1** – Using an eye pin, string 4mm grey pearl, 6mm crystal velvet, 4mm crystal velvet, 4mm Rosaline pearl, 6mm light rose, 4mm light rose and form a simple loop. Repeat 2 times for a total of 3 connectors.
2. **Connector 2** – Using an eye pin, string Rosaline pearl 4mm, 4mm light rose, 6mm light rose, 6mm crystal velvet, 4mm crystal velvet, 4mm grey pearl and form a simple loop. Repeat 1 time for a total of 2 connectors.
3. **Connecting the connectors** Using 8mm jump ring, attach connectors in the following order: 1,2,1,2,1 Make sure Connector 1 - 4mm light rose and Connector 2 - 4mm light gray are facing up and attach to the jump ring. Close jump ring.
4. **Border** – Cut a 4" length of 20g wire.
5. Using the very tip of chain nose pliers, flatten out the end of wire (smaller the better).

6. Slightly bend flatten end to the side. String 4mm Rosaline pearl. Using your fingernail, flatten wire to the side of pearl.
7. String connector 1, 3 rosaline pearls, connector 2, 3 rosaline pearls, connector 1, 3 rosaline pearls, connector 2, 3 rosaline pearls, connector 1, and 1 rosaline pearl.
8. Make sure beads are tight. Using chain nose pliers, flatten out the end of wire next to the bead (the smaller the better).
9. Trim off excess wire.
10. Using fingernail, flatten wire to the side of the pearl.
11. Attach ear wire to top of earring.
12. Repeat steps 1-11 for 2<sup>nd</sup> earring.
