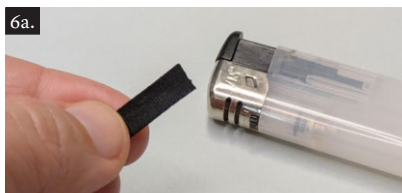


Step 6
The ribbon will serve as the fastening. Cut off 2 pieces of ribbon at a length of about 20 cm and melt the ends using the lighter (fig. no. 6a). Warm the bodkin with the lighter and make a hole at the end of the ribbon (fig. no. 6b). Then pass the end of the ribbon through the hole (fig. no. 6c). Repeat the procedure on the other end and the bracelet is finished.

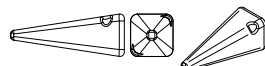

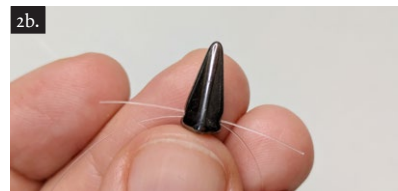
Technique: simple sewing

Procedure:

Step 1
Cut off about 1 m of line. Then string 10x **R10** and pull them to the centre of the line (fig. no. 1a). String 1x **PB** onto the ends of the line through both holes (fig. nos. 1b – 1c).



Step 2
String 1x **P** onto each end of the line (fig. no. 2a). then thread the line through a **V** from various sides (fig. nos. 2b – 2c). Repeat this step two more times (fig. nos. 2d – 2f).



Step 3
String 1x **PB** onto each end of the line (fig. nos. 3a – 3b) and then string a **PB** onto both ends of the line through both holes.



Step 4
Repeat Steps 2 and 3 until you have the required length of the bracelet (fig. no. 4).



Step 5
String 5x **R10** onto each end of the line (fig. no. 5a) and then pass each end of the line through all the beads and **PB** (fig. nos. 5b – 5c). Tie several knots and then cut off the ends of the line (fig. no. 5d).
